Recently, upon inspection of the Senior Playground, a structural issue was discovered that was beyond repair or salvage. The playground structure was removed immediately, and emergency funding was approved by the supervising Board to replace it with new playground equipment to be installed in October. As you know, GCCNS is a non-profit organization. Every year our parents generously volunteer their time and resources to perpetuate and secure the success of the school. Making a huge purchase, like replacing the Senior playground equipment, is unfortunately not an investment the school can afford on its own. We know this is ambitious, but we also know that it is worthwhile and necessary. We strive to offer our little students the best equipment and tools for development possible; we need the resources and support to keep that equipment up-to-date and, most importantly, safe. At this time, we humbly ask our parent community to consider supporting us with a donation to offset the enormous cost of

the new playground, so that the future students can enjoy a robust, durable and safe Senior playground for many, many years to come.
